- 1989: Recycling begins at U-M
- 1993: Partner on MRF & TS
- 1995: Sign contract






Details of Contract #1

- Dual stream
- Processing fee & 50% revenue share for recyclables
- Hauling fee + landfill fee for trash
- 10 year contract



10 Years Later - 2005

- Renegotiated contract
- Remained dual stream
- Interesting equation for recyclables
 - Guaranteed pricing& market-based
- Hauling fee + landfill fee for trash
- 10 year contract





5 Years Later - 2010

- Single-stream retrofit
- Additional materials accepted
- Processing fee & 65% revenue share for recyclables
 - Included maximum charge clause
- Hauling fee + landfill fee for trash
- Complete term of '05 contract





Remember...

- Don't be afraid to ask
- Be persistent and annoying
- Learn about peer contracts
 - But don't get too caught up in this
- Not confident? Negotiate for a short contract
