










HOW TO:

vour own.

 Get a FREE personal composting pail with lid from your hall's front desk...or if you prefer, you can get

Get a green certified compostable bag from your hall's front desk.

NO other bag types permitted in the compostable waste!

5. When the bag is full or AT LEAST

2-3 times a week, hand-tie it

closed and put it in your hall's

6. On your way back to your room,

another compostable bag and

stop by the front desk & get

REPEAT the process!

compost collection bin located in

the lower level of the traditional halls or lobby at the Suites @ 201.

3. Put the bag in your pail.

4. Fill it with acceptable

compostable waste.




Composting conclusions:
