10:00 to 11:30 – Interactive Activity Part 1: Shantanu Pai | Illinois Sustainable Technology Center- Using Material Management Data to Drive Waste Reduction, Diversion, and Engagement

These challenges limit us from thinking of our processes and systems in the abstract and innovate. Join us for a hands-on workshop to practice using waste data in the decision making process.
